


ACC Tampa Bay Community Service Event

Attendees were treated to an engaging presentation about sea turtles and their nesting habits in our area by <u>Sea Turtle Trackers</u>, a local nonprofit whose mission is to assure a suitable habitat for sea turtles, people, and the ecosystem of the islands and surrounding waters of St. Pete Beach and Shell Key Preserve.

Children also engaged with sea turtle themed arts and crafts. We ended our day with a beautiful sunset. ACC Tampa Bay and Quarles & Brady also collected donations to support End 68 Hours of Hunger and Kid Place, and held a raffle to raise funds for Sea Turtle Trackers. All involved had a wonderful time interacting, learning about sea turtles, and giving

back to our community during ACC's Global Community Service Month.
