As generative artificial intelligence (GenAI) continues to make significant advances, chief legal officers are taking the lead in embracing the new technology, according to new research from ACC in partnership with Everlaw, the cloud-native litigation and investigation platform.

The report — Gen Al and Future Corporate Legal Work: How Ready Are In-house Teams? — found that CLOs tend to utilize Al more frequently than their colleagues, are among the most likely to report efficiency gains from its use, and report having the best understanding of how to leverage GenAl tools effectively in their work.
